Dominion Coal Company Defers Dividend Action

MONTREAL, June 19 — (CP) — Because of the uncertain outlook arising from the recent strike, Company directors have so far considered it inadvisable to defer action on payment of dividends on preferred stocks for the current year. A. Cross, president of Dominion Coal Company Limited, announced at the annual meeting here today.

Mr. Cross also told shareholders that it is not possible at this time to give consideration to dividends in arrears in view of substantial sums required for contemplated capital expenditures. Arrears amounted to \$3 a share at the close of 1946.

Reports for 1945 and 1946 were approved and directors were re-elected including R. J. WYSE of Cleveland, Ohio, and Charles G. Terry of New York who were added to the Board several months ago.

Referring to the strike settlement, Mr. Cross said that operations only started last Monday and so far the company has not been dissatisfied with production.

He said that the Company cannot on the basis of the settlement operate the mines without loss until production is restored to a satisfactory level even after such sales price increases as are possible.

Financial assistance is being negotiated with the Federal Government to be on an entirely different basis from that heretofore provided which was based on cost of production. The new arrangement will be at a fixed amount per ton which will gradually be reduced as production per man increases.

"Restoration of production per man, say to at least the levels of 1930 is most definitely required if the industry is to survive," Mr. Cross said.

Present condition of the mines and the facilities as good as, and even better, than they were in 1930, and the mines are quite capable of yielding the required production.

"In the interest of all concerned, it is essential that every effort be made to restore the industry to a sound economic basis. With the cooperation of our employees we believe this can be done."
