House Turns Down Proposed Beer Tax

WASHINGTON, D. C. March 28—An unbridled House of Representatives yesterday brushed aside a beer tax proposal but approved a one-cent a gallon levy on imported oil as part of the New United States revenue bill.

More by chance than direction, it sustained the ways and means committee for the first time on the bill. It downed the legalized Beer Amendment 16 to 132 and accepted the oil import tax, 190 to 97. Both votes were by tellers.

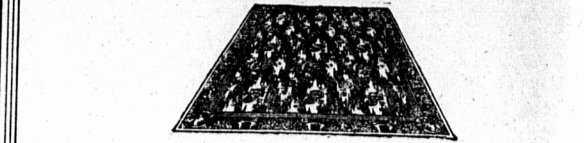
