BLACK FLIES SWARM IN TORONTO GARDEN

MONTREAL, Jan. 28.—Toronto has nearly all the signs of spring but the spring poet. The latest indication of a departing winter was observed yesterday afternoon in the garden of F. F. Rover. ACTION AGAINST HON. SAM. HUGHES

MONTREAL, Que., Jan. 28.—"Therefore the plaintiff prays that the defendant be condemned in the sum of \$10,000 damages for reasons set forth, and while considering the monetary damages of secondary importance, further prays for an unconditional writ of retraction, failing which, the defendant be condemned to a course of imprisonment in the common jail of Montreal conformable to law."

This statement concludes the inscription on writ on the action brought by B. A. McNab, late editor of the Montreal Star against Hon. Sam Hughes, minister of militia, for \$10,000 damages for alleged slander, which was filed to-day.

Elsewhere in the writ, the plaintiff alleges that the minister of militia in July, 1912, informed a well known man in journalism in Montreal, that the (plaintiff) with the late Lt.-Col. Worthington, of Sherbrooke, were interested in the small arms company of England, and that for a monetary consideration or otherwise, had conspired to campaign against the House of Lords. That further, while McNab was in England on a matter of national importance last July, that Hon. Mr. Hughes had stated that he could ruin him and that he had documentary evidence which he could use to that effect.

DRANK OXALIC ACID.

NEW YORK, Jan. 27.—Unable to read the English language, Francisco Samuasi drank oxalic acid instead of Epsom salts, and died in a few minutes. A label on the bottle described the contents.
