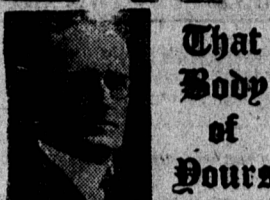

Our farmers will be in a better position to understand the attitude of the King Government from an illuminating statement in its partisan press. As is well known, dairy organizations throughout Canada, including the Dairy Association of Prince Edward Island, have been appealing for protection in the home market against the wholesale dumping of New Zealand butter under a tariff so low that the foreign product can be sold at less than the cost of winter production of Canadian butter.

Canning Potatoes

Competition in the potato market is increasing every year, and it may be advisable for our farmers to consider in future the possibility of canning their surplus product when prices drop below production cost.

That Hon. Mr. Crearer will not be opposed in the by-election in Brandon by a Conservative has been announced and this seems to be a sensible course. No good object would be served by his defeat except some Conservative prestige of a very temporary nature, and even that unexpected and improbable result were achieved.

Political opinion in the Prairie Provinces has been gradually taking shape along different lines from those of the past. Many new factories have been established which give permanent employment and this is steadily reducing the once prevalent opposition to protection.

Mr. Crearer in a recent speech stressed the great benefits which he claimed the Progressives and farmers organizations had brought to the agricultural interests of the Dominion. Probably this claim is not so well founded as he thinks it is, but it was a politic move to refer to it as he did.

It is satisfactory that we know the date when Parliament will meet and the state of the Dominion finances the public debt, the monthly receipts from customs, excise and other sources, the earnings and expenditures by the Government railways as compared with corresponding months of the previous year, and so on.

The Provincial Government has large powers of taxation and the budget for last year forecast a deficit. This either means that new sources of revenue must be found or further borrowing resorted to and new taxation imposed.

When Parliament meets no doubt the usual statement will be made by the Prime Minister as to changes in the Cabinet that have taken place since the last session.

The American public has grown accustomed to beans, peas, nuts, tomatoes and various other vegetables put up in cans, but that staple vegetable the potato has always been served fresh until this year. Now it also is available in a canned form.

The sorrows and the joys of life alike pass down forgotten ways; And only one thing rests secure And still is lovely, still is pure—the country stays.

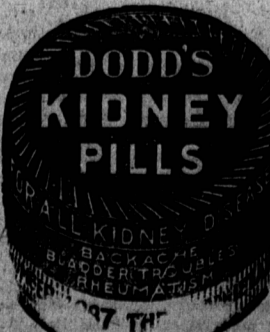
