Search Dutch Guinea For U. S. Aviator

(C. F. Cable By Guardian's Special Wire)

GEORGETOWN, British Guiana, Dec. 12 - Dispatches reaching here from Paramaribo, Dutch Guiana, stated two expeditions were pushing through rough hinterland today toward a tiny Indian village in Brazil in search of Paul Red-

fern, United States aviator who has been missing since he crashed eight years ago on a flight to Rio De Janeiro.

Art Williams, former United States army pilot who taught Redfern to fly, had divided his aerial party of four and was leading one party by canoe up a small river toward the village where the American pilot is believed to be living, crippled and held by a tribe of uncivilized Indians.

Another party, including J. W. Roch and G. Pacht and operating from Paramaribo, left Paramaribo

three days ago and promised to return with Redfern "inside a hundred days."

(C.P.) - Illness due to advanced age brought death today to Dr. Mary McLeod, 83, first New Brunswick woman to become a doctor and one of the earliest women doctors in North America.

Her medical career was largely concerned with hospital work in the United States. A period of gradual retirement began with her return to New Brunswick 25 years ago.
