ATTRACTION AT THE OPERA HOUSE

The St. John Telegraph commenting on the Robinson Opera Coy's presentation of "Fra Diavolo" says: The Robinson Opera Company opened a short engagement in the Opera House last evening at Auber's three-act romantic opera Fra Diavolo, and received a hearty welcome from a capacity audience. The opera was especially well sung and the impression obtained was that the company is stronger this year than on previous occasions and capable of finished productions of all In an open company featuring the operas in their repertoire, Frank Nelson no better bill than Fra Diavolo is obtainable for an opening vehicle. With the exception of The Bohemian Girl, Auber's opera gives the popular baritone the greatest opportunity to display his excellent voice. He received a hearty welcome last evening and all his solos were encored. His acting in the last act (the death scene) was also particularly good. Much interest attached to the appearance of Miss Lucie Nola, soprano prima donna of the company, who sang the role of Zerlina. Her Diavolo solo in the first act and her work in duet with Mr Nelson showed her to be possessed of a rich singing voice of good range and excellent cultivation. Her upper register is distinctly pure and sweet and throughout she displayed tone quality far above the average of road companies. In the second act she sang My Love is Like the Red, Red Rose with much expression.

John O'Donnell is the tenor of the company and he sang Lorenzo in good vein. His best work was done in the last act. Miss Essie Barton sang Lady Allcash and made the best of a part which offered little opportunity, while George Le Roy filled all the requirements of Lord Allcash. The comedy roles of Beppo and Gramomo were in the hands of Jack Leslie and Edward Beck. Mr Leslie is an unctuous comedian, much on the lines of Jack Henderson. He supplied much fun and was ably seconded by his companion, who has that rare attribute of a comic opera comedian—a magnificent bass voice. In an interpolated number, The Rubber Chief in the last act, he brought down the house, and was encored several times.

STEAMER NOW OVER DUE.

HALIFAX, Dec 7.—Anxiety is felt for the Rosalind which piles between New York and Halifax and St. John. The Rosalind left Halifax on Tuesday morning for St. John. On Wednesday morning Halifax received a "wireless" from the Cape station that the Rosalind had run into a fierce storm. The weather was so bad that the steamer had made only eighty miles since leaving Halifax. Ordinarily the Rosalind makes a run to St. John in fifty hours.
