WINNIPEG, Feb. 17 (CP)— Firmness in outside markets and constructive interpretation of the Dominion Government's announcement last night that the minimum price for wheat to farmers would be discontinued during the coming crop year caused Winnipeg wheat futures prices to lean to the upside throughout most of today's session. Stock Prices Close Lower In New York

NEW YORK, Feb. 17 (AP)—The stock market lost its rallying urge today as many traders cashed out profits on Thursday's upswing. While there were few weak spots in evidence, closing prices were irregularly lower. Declines were mainly in small fractions, a number of favorites emerged with modest plus signs.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was off 3 of a point at 50.4. Transfers amounted to 692, 010 shares compared with 852,000 the day before.

There was little movement in the Canadian department. Dominion was steady while Distillers Seagram, International Nickel, Brazillian and Lake Shore lost fractionally. Other issues were inactive. Among shares in the final hour's retreat were U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, Chrysler, General Motor, Sears Roebuck, Montgomery Ward, Anaconda, Consolidated Edison, Sears Roebuck American Telephone.

Ahead at the finish were Boeing, International Harvester, Great Northern, American Smelting, N. Y. Omnibus, Quett Foodco, Lot, P. P. Owens-Illinois and Eastman Kodak.
