Synopsis of Canadian North-West

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS. ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section 160 acres, more or less.

Applications for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Subagency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may however be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father or mother, son, daughter or other or sister of any intending homesteader.

(1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years. (2) A homesteader may, if so desired perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a residence homestead entered for by him in the vicinity of the homestead.

(3) If the father or mother, if the father deceased of homesteader has perma residence on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a residence homestead entered for by him in the vicinity of the homestead, he may perform his own residence duties by living with the father or mother.

(4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than nine miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowance crossed in the measurement.
