A despatch from Ottawa to many newspapers mentioned that Premier Farragut's recent mission to the capital had relation to our provincial finances. What success was met with has not yet been disclosed and is a matter of some speculation and anxiety. No province of the Dominion, excepting Quebec is so much cramped financially as is Prince Edward Island. Quebec has been notoriously extravagant, successive Governments there having run the Province in debt to the amount of 25 to 30 millions. In that regard no Province has been more prudent than our own, notwithstanding conflicting party charges, and some means must be found for restoring the balance between revenue and expenditure. Either we must receive more from the federal treasury, or taxation must be increased, or the expenditure upon various public services must be curtailed to a very considerable extent.

The citizens of Charlottetown are to be commended for the generosity with which they have subscribed to the Monument Fund. It is now time that further subscriptions from the country were coming in and we hope soon to have lists from the school teachers and others to whom circulars were sent out. The time is now very long before the date of closing and ought to be improved. It may be noted in this connection that Charlottetown will be by no means the only Canadian city to have a Soldiers' Monument as the result of the South African war. In Nova Scotia about \$8,000 is already subscribed toward a \$10,000 monument in Halifax. In the West, Brantford and other cities are moving in the same direction. The movement will probably spread throughout the Dominion. The men who fought and fell, and the great struggle in which they took part are worthy of the recognition thus to be given.

It is gratifying to learn that in New York City the number of deaths from the "white plague," consumption, is steadily diminishing. In 1886 there were 443 deaths from consumption; in 1890, 394; in 1894, 316 and in 1897 only 282, and this notwithstanding the great increase of the city's population. In England and Wales, while the mortality from consumption is still very large—13 per 10,000 this year—it is to be remembered that this is only about one third of the rates of half a century past. In 1838 the deaths from consumption there were 38 per 10,000 of population.

It was in the Far West that Bryan met with his heaviest losses as compared with 1896. He lost Kansas, Nebraska, South Dakota, Wyoming, Utah and Washington, McKinley, while carrying every New England State, lost in each a portion of his 1896 majority, his losses ranging from 9,000 in Rhode Island to 80,000 in Massachusetts. He also lost ground in the Middle States, but gained in the Middle West as in the Far West.

The London Speaker, an organ of Liberal opinion in England, has not much hope for President McKinley's policy in the Philippines. The Speaker says: "That the half-barbarous, tropical Philippines, with millions of inhabitants, can be conquered and administered by the volunteers of an un-military democracy, living in a temperate climate on the other side of the world, is a fantastic notion."

A railway of great importance and interest is now under construction from Michipicoten on Lake Superior to Moose Factory on Hudson's Bay.
