(Canadian Press) MONTREAL, Oct. 23—Cheese and butter quotations advanced on the Montreal produce and dairy market today. Improving export demand for end of the season shipment pushed cheese 1/4 to 3/4 of a cent. No 1 Ontario white was quoted at 9 1/2 and extra at 9 1/4. A large No 2 Quebec white was 8 1/2 cents with colored at 8 1/4 cents. Receipts were 881 boxes.

Fresh no 1 butter in cartons of less than 50 lbs. 57c. Receipts by rail were 572 boxes. Eggs in cartons of less were firm at 38 1/2 to 39 cents for A medium, 38 to 39 cents for B medium, 37 to 38 cents for C. Receipts totaled 1,281 cases.

Prices Edward Island stock entered the Quebec market today quoted at 45 to 50 cents per 50 pound bag. New Brunswick were 40 to 45 cents and Quebec 35 to 40 cents per 50 pound bag.
