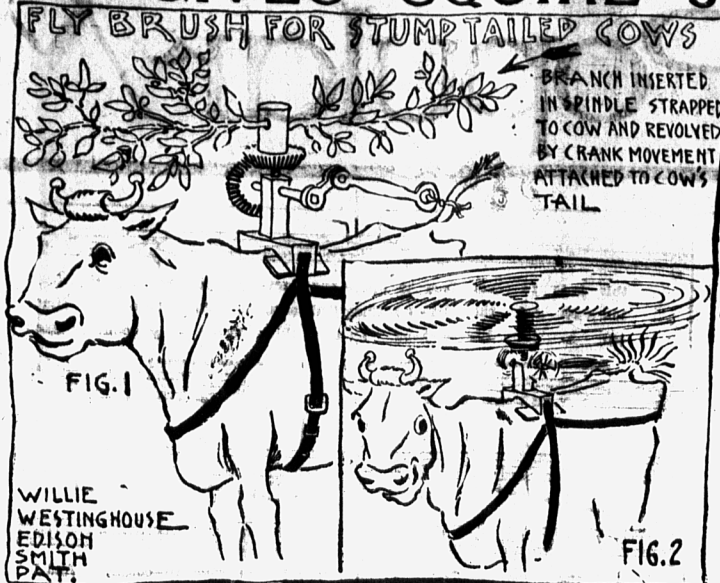


WILLIE WESTINGHOUSE GIVES SQUIRE JONES A MILK BATH

That I made a machine like this. When she switches her tail it revolves the brush and shoos the flies off

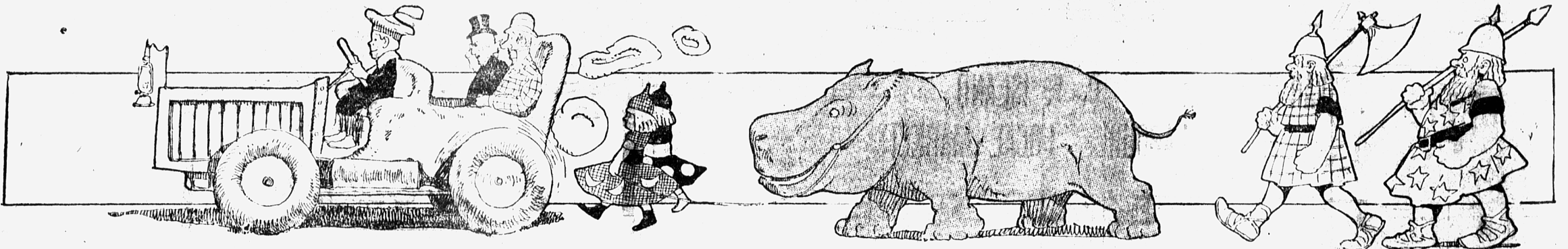
Squire Jones happened over just as we were trying it.
