## CALLS ON BRITAIN TO SAVE THE EMPIRE

London Times Sees Great Danger--If Trade Treaties With United States and Germany Are Negotiated the Preference Will Be Reduced or Wiped Out.

MONTREAL, Dec. 15.—A special London correspondent cable says: "Germany on Canada's doors" is the title of one of today's articles on the tariff question. The Times and Standard and other journals show that the English people are beginning to realize the possibly vital consequences to British trade, and even British connection, involved in the new Canadian tariff policy. The Times says: "It is in the intermediate tariff that the importance of Mr. Fielding's departure lies. Its announcement is practically equivalent to an invitation from the Canadian government to the world at large and the United States in particular, to enter into commercial negotiations on the basis of reciprocal concessions."

"What would the acceptance of that invitation involve for us? It would, undoubtedly, even as the Canadian offer stands at present, mean a very considerable reduction in the preference enjoyed by this country, but it requires very little acquaintance with the process of bargaining, which accompanies the framing of commercial treaties, to realize that in practice the Canadian intermediate tariff would be substantially reduced in the course of arriving at an agreement."

### SEES DANGER OF LOSING CANADA.

"The British preference would consequently be still further narrowed if it did not disappear entirely. It is impossible to

contemplate the effect of this upon our trade with any satisfaction, but the misfortune is one which cannot be averted as long as we cling to our present economic policy. Those who have nothing to bargain with cannot complain if their interests are not consulted."

"Have we no duty, no imperial obligation to use every effort to avert the possibility of the absorption of Canada into the United States?"

"Can we afford to let economic theories, whether true or false, stand in the way of measures which would safeguard the Empire against that danger?"

"It is not an abstract question of free trade or protection that the government of this country has to decide, but an urgent, concrete issue of imperial unity or disruption. What its attitude is to that issue will be shown at the forthcoming imperial conference. If it is an attitude of sympathy and good will of readiness to further any measure conducive to unity, then the danger may be averted, even if it may not be possible to secure immediately that economic bond of union against which the government is so hopelessly committed, but if the government's attitude is merely one of polite reserve, profuse hospitality veiling real indifference, then Canada and her sister states will inevitably come to the conclusion that England is incapable of empire, political or economic, and will turn their attention elsewhere."

## DIFFERENT FROM DOMINION HOUSE

Voted Down Salary Increase to Themselves, But Raised Officials Pay.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 15.—By a vote of 100 to 188 the house of representatives today refused to increase from \$5,000 to \$7,000 the salaries of senators, members and delegates. The house, however, by an overwhelming vote, increased the salaries of the vice-president, the speaker of the house and members of the president's cabinet to \$12,000 each.

In anticipation of the question of increasing salaries coming before the house, there was an exceedingly large membership present and the debate on the several amendments for increase which were offered by Mr. Littauer of New York, to the legislative appropriation bill was followed with marked interest.

After disposing of salary questions the house passed the legislative, executive and judicial appropriation bill.

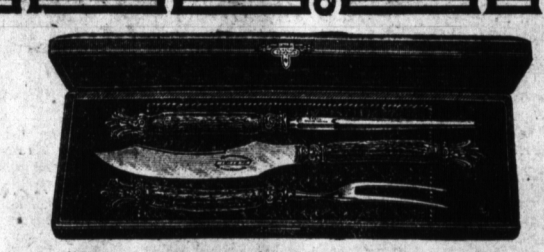
