duce at least 200 pounds of butter fat or about 5,600 pounds of milk annually if she is to pay her way. This means 10 pounds of milk daily for 300 days. The annual cost of maintaining a cow is close to \$65, if a man values his labor at 15 cents an hour. If a man wants more than a market price for feed and this bare wage, he must put his time on cows giving more than 200 pounds of fat. The larger the increase over this amount the larger his pay will be, remarks Francis W. Peck, of the University Farm, St. Paul.
