Livestock

MONTREAL, April 13 (CP) - Calves were the high feature on the Montreal livestock market today showing 856 heads. Cattle listed 314, sheep at 50 and hogs at 562. Calves were around 25 cents lower. Cattle firm and hogs steady. Good steers sold from \$10 to \$10.60 medium from \$9 to \$10, common from \$7 to \$8.50. Good heifers made \$9 to \$9.50, medium \$8 to \$8.75, and common from \$6 to \$7.50. Odd baby heaves sold from \$9 to \$11. Good cows were \$7.50 to \$8, mostly \$7.75 to \$8, medium \$6.50 to \$7.50, and common butchers \$6 to \$6.50. Canners and cutters were \$4 to \$5.75. Good bulls made \$8 to \$8.75. A couple of young bulls weighing 800 pounds or better sold for \$9 to \$10 per hundredweight. Common bulls were \$6.50 to \$7.75.

Montreal Exchange

MONTREAL, April 13 (CP) - Prices were irregularly lower on the average in trading today on the stock exchange and curb market. Easier in industrials on the stock market were Dosco "B," Dominion Coal preferred, National Steel Car, Price Brothers and St. Lawrence Corporation "A," Alcohol "A," Canadian Car and Massey-Harris picked up fractional gains. Bell Telephone and Montreal Power were both in arrears among utilities but in carriers C.P.R. and Canada Steamship worked into higher ground. Consolidated Smelters was out in front in pivotal metals and International Nickel and Hudson Bay Mining back-pedaled. National Breweries and Associated Breweries were softer in the miscellaneous section. Total sales: 17,070 shares; Industrials, 9,200; Mines, 7,800.

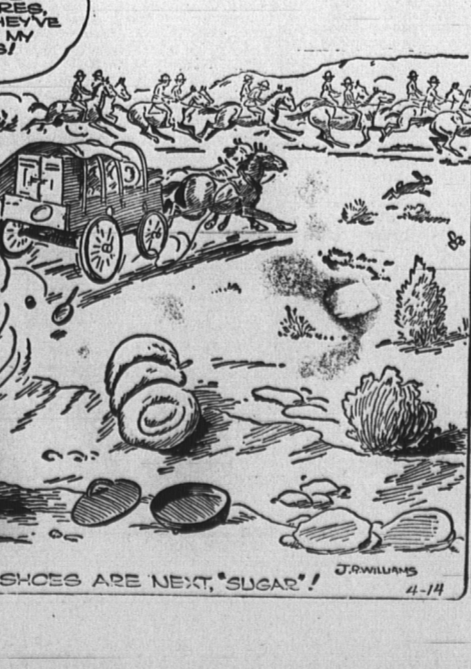
