F. K. Contracts

There should be some definite announcement from the Dominion-Provincial Conference meeting in Ottawa regarding our bacon, eggs, cheese and other food contracts for next year.

Recent developments have given more hope for a favourable contract. However, farmers would have had some definite word in this at least two months ago in order to plan their production.

No doubt our Island representatives on their return will also have some definite word on the future of the marketing situation and on the possibilities of floor prices. At the present time, conditions in the American and Canadian markets lead us to believe that there will be a normal or even greater demand for Foundation and Foundation A seed after the New Year.

Queens County Meeting

Queens County farmers have arranged to hold the organizational meeting of their County Federation on Tuesday afternoon in Charlottetown.

The meeting will be held at the P. W. C. Vocational Training School at one o'clock sharp.

If our farm organizations are to do a real job for Agriculture then they must be controlled and directed by the farm people. The aim of the County Federation is to have contacts in every school district so that valuable hints on future marketing prospects and other timely information can be directed to the farmers. And at the same time have a means of getting the reaction of the farm people to certain problems and policies affecting their interests.

The proposed constitution requires that at least five ladies be on the County Board of Directors, one from each electoral district.

It is hoped that farmers will arrange to show their support by turning out Monday. If at least two farm people from every school district in the County attend this meeting we can lay a solid foundation for our County unit. This will be similar to the setup through which farm people in other Provinces and Counties are at last gaining recognition.

Prince County Directors

The first directors meeting of the newly organized Prince County Federation was held in Summerside Tuesday afternoon. Everyone of the fifteen directors appointed were present. Plans were drawn up for carrying on the organizational work, establishing contacts and arranging for membership in 150 school districts in the County was set as a goal for this winter.

"This does not mean that meetings must be held frequently or that any complicated set-up be arranged in the district. It only requires that there will be a contact in each school district for the Federation in order to get the farmers' opinions and take action if and when necessary and also that two meetings be held in the Fall. One immediately preceding the County meeting to discuss farm problems and appoint delegates, and another following the County meeting to receive a report from the delegates and take any further action that is necessary."
