COOK AND PEARY AS RIVAL POLE-FINDERS.

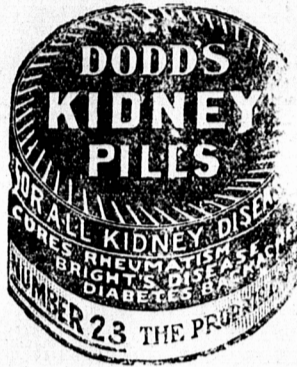

The Guardian does not share Rutherford's alarm with regard to the private slaughter house, at least so far as this city is concerned, and we do not believe a municipal abattoir would be conducted with any more care, or cleanliness, or with more regard for the health of the public than are the better class of private slaughter houses.

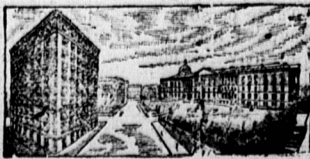
