Cook's Corner

EGG-WHITE CAKE

- 2 cups once-sifted pastry flour or 1 1/2 cups once-sifted hard-what flour
 - 2 teaspoons baking powder
 - 1/4 teaspoon salt
 - 8 tablespoons shortening
 - 1 cup fine granulated sugar
 - 2/3 cup milk
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla
 - 3 egg-whites
- Measure and sift together three times the flour, baking powder and salt.
- Cream shortening and blend in the sugar.
- Combine the milk and vanilla.

A. Mix one quart of good vinegar, 2 ounces butter of antimony, 2 ounces alcohol, one quart of oil. Always shake thoroughly before using.

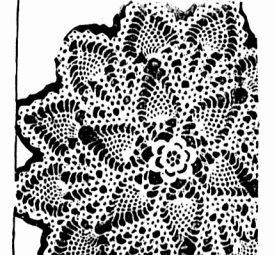
Q. How can I protect the nose and throat when dusting or sweeping?
