HOG PRODUCERS ATTENTION
 With a heavy seasonal run of hogs moving, and likely to continue for some time, occasional DISLOCATIONS in regular marketing practice such as we have already experienced, may occur again. But, not if necessary, if we take precautions and exercise a measure of control.
 A large percentage of our hogs must be shipped out of the Province so they can be processed for the export trade, and to avoid a glut on the local markets. Hence we come in direct competition with hogs from other Provinces, and together with such, can easily create a BOTTLENECK that will cause inconveniences, delays, and in some instances, serious loss.
 These situations can be largely, if not indeed entirely, eliminated by a bit of team work between the Packer to whom they are assigned, the Marketing Board and the Producer.
 The Packer is willing to give us a weekly quota to cover our shipping needs—if he knows in advance what that need will be. The Marketing Board will make all necessary arrangements if it gets the information, and the Producer is being asked to supply the information. Here is the plan:
 If you have hogs to ship at a certain time, please notify the Marketing Board receiving Agent at your local station the previous week. That's all. Simple isn't it? Yes, but it is IMPORTANT. The whole scheme of orderly marketing depends upon whether farmers had their hogs in advance or not. We are operating under a quota system now and we sincerely ask that all producers co-operate with us so that an efficient marketing service can be provided.
