TIME TABLE—CAPES ROUTE

Sir:—Every British subject certainly possesses the right to protest against any and everything, but the power of that protest is always impaired when the subject resorts too frequently to its use. History is full of incidents where great men protested until they became a nuisance.

As regards the Railway time-table now in force, it simply has that disturbing influence on trade that follows every change. That disturbing influence is more apparent from a local stand point.

Take Tignish for instance. The Railway discriminates against the village inasmuch that it tends to draw its country custom to Alberton.

As for Summerside, the capital of the West the destination of nine-tenths of the Western travelling public, the arrangement is good, as it allows passengers time, not only to make their purchases at the stores, but to visit any of the county offices which they may have occasion to do, so that, looking at the matter from the many local standpoints and taking the circumstances in regard to the number of trains into consideration, we feel that the Superintendent had a difficult problem to solve. Allow me, Sir, to say, that we are pleased to have you claim that the Government should own and operate the ferries between the I. C. Railway and the P. E. Island Railway as we believe a private company would simply mean a buffer between the people and the Federal Government in which case, the good things would go to the Company. The Minister of Railways having lately given us a glimpse of his views on this matter, and knowing his chief characteristics we may soon expect a decided move towards the consummation of our hope.

If the Capes is the place for the tunnel, then it would seem that the Cape is the place for the ferry.

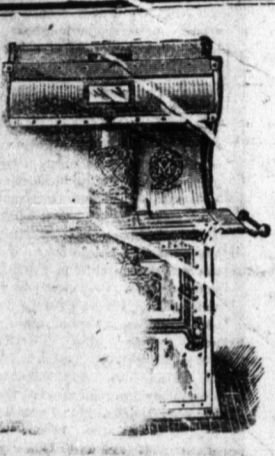
