## MINING CAMP OBLITERATED

NOME, ALASKA, Oct. 16, (Special.)—The steamship Victoria, after discharging cargo at Nome, sailed recently for Solomon, a placer mining camp of 300 inhabitants, forty miles southeast of here, which is reported to have been entirely destroyed by the recent tidal storm. The Victoria is expected to bring away those who wish to leave.

More than a score of lives is believed to have been lost in the storm. Beside the eight persons drowned at Nome, more than a dozen are reported to have perished from small vessels at sea. Nearly all the gasoline boats in northern Bering Sea were demolished.

Most of the Eskimos on Seward Peninsula have been rendered destitute. Only one native house at the village of Sinuk, near Cape Rodney is left standing. The missionary building, two school houses and the winter supply of coal were destroyed.

### BRADDOCK MEMORIAL DEDICATION

UNIONTOWN, Pa., Oct. 15.—Interesting exercises today attended the unveiling, in Braddock Memorial Hall near this city, of the monument erected in honor of the memory of General Edward Braddock, who was killed while leading the British regulars and the Virginia militia against the French and Indians at Fort Duquesne. Prominent among those who took part in the unveiling exercises were Sir Cecil A. Spring-Rice, the British ambassador at Washington, and Philander C. Knox, the former secretary of state.

## HE CLAIMS TO HAVE A CURE FOR LEPROSY.

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, Oct. 15.—Local scientists have received with intense interest the news from Honolulu that Dr. James-Thomas Wayson, Jr., graduate of the university in the class of 1891, in charge of a government hospital at Honolulu, has obtained marvelous results in the treatment of leprosy. The local application of the carbon dioxide snow pencil, which freezes the skin in repeated treatment, is the treatment which Dr. Wayson is using and by which he has effected a number of cures.

The territorial board of health has passed upon several cases under Dr. Wayson's treatment and found them so well cured that their patrol from the leper's settlement has been ordered. The board says in a recent report:—

"Dr. Wayson has been particularly successful in the treatment of incipient cases and those with localized lesions.

Regarding the methods, Dr. Wayson has this to say, in an annual report he has just published.

"I fully believe that with our present medical and surgical knowledge relative to leprosy, which has been gained by actual experience, the majority of lepers, if taken in the incipient stage, can be cured, even as such as tuberculosis in its incipient stage. Unfortunately the majority of the medical men, as well as the people must be educated to the fact; otherwise our knowledge means but little toward eradicating the disease in Hawaii. In the advanced cases that come under our care we can only benefit them in a small way.

The slow method of using the carbonic acid snow pencil in incipient cases, where the lesions, are so circumscribed, undoubtedly causes the death of the lepra bacilli, and with their absorption into the tissues produces a self-immunization of vaccine effect, affecting not only the local lesions in evidence, but all other foci in such are present.

"This self-immunizing effect is shown in the so-called 'abortive cases,' wherein the ulnar nerves alone are affected, it being purely a local condition."

## THE DEAF ARE MADE TO HEAR THROUGH RADIUM EXAMINATIONS.

BERLIN, Oct. 15.—Another impetus has been given to the already unsuppressible demand for radium and mesothorium for medical purposes by a report, printed in a Berlin clinical weekly by Dr. Hugel, saying that he has had remarkable success in the treatment of deafness and partial deafness with mesothorium and radium emanations. In view of the fact that it is estimated that over a half a million persons in Germany are deaf or hard of hearing, Dr. Hugel's discovery is attracting attention in both medical and lay circles. Dr. Hugel reports that mesothorium rays have proven effective in almost all forms of partial deafness, and even where the disease has been chronic supuration and uncerated of long standing has quickly disappeared. Dr. Hugel claims that the most interesting part of the treatment of the ears is that the rays revive the tissues and nerves.


