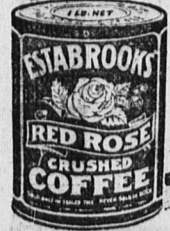

### EMPERESS ZITA IS A THORN IN SIDE OF KAISER BUT IDOL OF VIENNA.

ZURICH, Switzerland, Oct. 27.—It has fallen to Mrs. Frederick Penfield, wife of the Ambassador to the Hapsburg court from the United States, to express in wholly inadequate words the wholesome nature of the first Empress the Dual Empire has had since the murder of Empress Elizabeth on Lake Geneva. In 1898. Mrs. Penfield on being presented to the winning lady, declared enthusiastically: "She is everything that is sweet and simple, and withal a woman; every inch a queen."

Her name, Zita, brings visions of romantic Latin vineyards luxuriously absorbing a Mediterranean sun; of little vividly colored villas nestling in clumps of deep green vegetation, a refreshment in itself. Before the young Emperor brought his wife to Vienna the merry younger court circle had formed a dainty opinion of the new Empress Zita—and there was no disappointment for them, for she proved to be as chaste and pure and dainty as her name implied. Girlish of figure, with queenly grace, a small, well poised head; dark, sparkling eyes and a mouth that expresses a character womanly and ravishing at once. And, whisper, Empress Zita is so anti-Hohenzollern that she has snubbed the War Lord to his face.

She is an excellent equestrienne and an expert shot, a lover of the great wilderness and ozonated mountains which tumble tinkling streams of living water from heights on heights.

It was on the Isle of Wight that the little Zita was courted at the beginning of the royal romance. Of course, she would smile and tell her friends how little she cared for the young Prince Charles, but she was thinking—and that, was something. She was of the house of Bourbon Parma and Charles had a little bit of pride to overcome. A year later they met at Franzensbad and in the winter at a state ball at the Hofburg in Vienna. Charles singled out Zita for his very particular attention and favorite partner in the dances. On October 21, 1911, they were married. The twain were joined only after they had managed to outwit certain machinations set on foot by Kaiser Wilhelm to alienate their affections. It is said the match hurt the German Emperor, for he had determined on linking the houses by a royal match between his daughter Louise and the young Prince Charles Francis Joseph.

### A Prominent Role.

During a recent visit of the Austrian Emperor and Empress to the Hohenzollerns, Zita played a prominent role. It has been arranged for only Emperor Charles to go to the German Great Headquarters, but the Empress insisted on journeying with him. As Charles had always made a confidant of his Empress, he decided to have her with him. When she faced the Kaiser she spoke plainly on the possibilities of peace. Firmly she emphasized that peace could be brought about at that time. When several burly German strategists were

assigned to instill in her a rapid education in military and political tactics she wrathfully conducted a little propaganda on her own line. In vain did the corpulent officers endeavor to explain to her the promising position of the imperial armies. Loudly and firmly she presented her very logical case and then precipitately quit the conference. It is ascribed to her influence on the Emperor that Charles has several times endeavored to win over the German high command to some sort of an armistice. In her opinion the "house of Hapsburg and Hohenzollern stand over a crater."

### Witty and Pretty.

And it is this witty, beautiful Zita who is destined to bear a heavy hand in the destinies of Central Europe. Zita is a fluent conversationalist in many languages and dialects. She is versed in obtruse sciences and arts; her education is flawless and her natural aptitude is peerless. The young Emperor has been educated for the Crown, for it has long been a superstition that Ferdinand, the assassinated Archduke, would never occupy the throne. The twain promise Austria-Hungary the strongest Government known for several generations. And the woman in the case, the power behind the throne, is Zita, the idol of Vienna.
