THE following is taken from the Cape Times, of 13th September:—Lieutenant Arthur J. B. Mellish, A. D. C. to governor of Prince Edward Island, Canada, an officer in the 82 Battalion Royal Canadian Infantry militia, and who has served throughout the present war as a private in the ranks of Royal Canadian regiment of Infantry, has recently been invalided to Wynberg. Mr. Mellish is a barrister-at-law and a graduate of Harvard University, and is but one of a large number of Canadians who willingly sacrificed a life of comparative ease for the honor of fighting the enemies of the Queen. Lieut Mellish was with his company (G) in the long march from Belmont to Pretoria, and fought in all the engagements. At Thaba N'Chu he was thrown into the air by an exploding shell, and at Zand River received a slight wound in the leg from a Mouser. A short time ago while on duty on armoured train, he took ill and was sent to the hospital, from whence he sailed in the Kildonan Castle for London, where he arrived a few days ago. At last accounts he was well on the road toward recovery.
