CINCINNATI, Jan. 2.—At a meeting of the Transvaal sympathizers held last week a toast to the "United States of South Africa" was proposed by the chairman, who mentioned the members of the future government, Natal, Cape Colony, Orange Free State, Transvaal and Swaziland.

Mr. Von Alitow, a relative of President Kruger, made a speech, in the course of which he said: "We have now 4000 Americans well drilled in Pretoria, with 2000 more on the way. Funds are coming from all parts of this broad land. We may need 50,000 men, but we are satisfied that we can have them on time, even with the British blockade."
