SPRAYING OF FRUIT TREES.

A great deal has been written and expounded by Institute speakers from platforms about the spraying of fruit trees. In the majority of cases, upon the most important part the least has been said, (i. e.) the time the spray should be put on. It has been said that you can prune a tree whenever the saw is sharp. With spraying it is just the opposite, more particularly the first spraying. Prof. Wallace in his address before the N. S. F. G. A. meeting at Windsor last year said, "He was satisfied that hundreds of thousands of dollars were lost each year to the fruit growers in the State of New York by not putting the spray at the right time."

We feel safe in saying if ever there was a time that the first spraying should be made it is the present week and probably an of next.

To those who may think the buds are too far advanced, we feel safe in saying that there will be no danger at all this week and probably the one following, unless the buds expand faster than ordinary seasons.

The Nova Scotia Carriage and Motor Car Company made rapid progress in output and earning capacity, particularly during the last three or four years. Last year the advance was still more marked, and in the five months of the current year a further notable advance has taken place.

The management had their orders of carriages out this season three weeks earlier than the record of a year ago, and the quantity is larger. The profit on the five months' business is stated by the company to be \$40,000. This proportion will doubtless continue during the rest of the year, so that at the end of the twelve months it should be close to \$100,000.

The estimate of the management, based on what they had accomplished before, and on orders in hand, was for \$30,500, which, after payment of bond interest and a full year's preference dividends, would leave a surplus of \$47,500. It will, however, it is estimated, more closely approximate \$60,000.

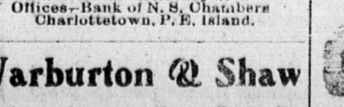
