WHAT CITY COMMISSION GOVERNMENT IS.

An article in a recent issue of The Guardian on government by commission has led to some inquiries for further information on the subject.

The bill provides for the abolition of the present city council, which is elected by wards, and the substitution of a commission of five members who shall have full control of and be responsible for the good government of the city.

The manner of electing Commissioners is this: Three weeks prior to the regular election a primary election is held.

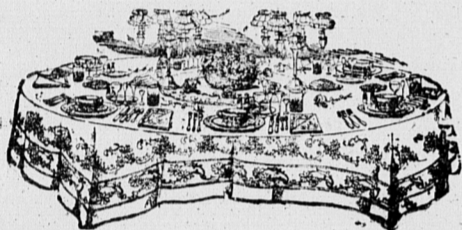
