Fishermen in Trouble Over Income Taxes

BOSTON, Dec. 18 —(CP)—Hundreds of fishermen in New England ports will be prosecuted as income tax evaders for failing to report "tremendous profits" made in the war years. It was disclosed yesterday by Judge Leo P. Doherty, counsel for the U.S. Internal Revenue Department. A special prosecutor from New York city will arrive today to assist in presenting several cases to a federal grand jury. "An inspection of income tax reports filed by masters of fishing vessels and fishermen has given us an abundance of facts to substantiate our charges," Judge Doherty said. He declined to reveal the amount of the alleged evasions, but said the figures were "high". Judge Doherty stated the present "outrageously high" prices of fish indicated that the industry is a lucrative one.
