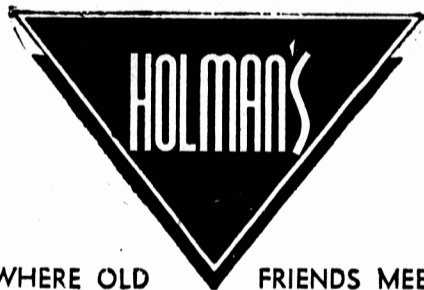

blonde Esquimaux in the year 1910. Theophilus made headquarters in Nome Alaska from 1905 till 1910. Stephenson hadn't been seen or heard from for over a year and it was feared that he was lost. Mr. Peter Bernard (Theophilus' uncle) lost his life with Stephenson's expedition in Banks Land. Another brother, captain of the famous northern exploration ship Teddy Bear, was the first to bring news to the outside world that Stephenson was alive and was encamped in an immense ice floe in Bering Sea. Stephenson eventually came back to civilization and was bestowed with honors and emoluments. The Bernard brothers were famous "mushers", having made the one thousand mile journey from Nome to Valdez by way of the Yukon and Tanana Rivers and Fairbanks to Valdez on the Pacific coast of Alaska in midwinter, in temperatures constantly between 40 and 50 degrees below zero. The Bernards are prominent figures in exploration "sagas" of the north.

They are cousins of Governor J. A. Bernard.—K.

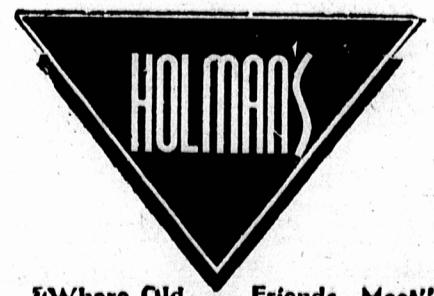

"SWEET GENEVIEVE" HALF OF DOUBLE BILL AT CAPITOL, SUMMERSIDE

—Movie fans can expect a real treat in Columbia's "Sweet Genevieve" now at the Capitol Theatre. That will keep audiences absorbed for this dramatic musical is said to

A NEW USE FOR YOUR PEN

If you have a ball-point pen, you have, automatically, a good safe-deposit container for large bills. Most ball pens have plenty of room in the barrel around the thin ink-supply tube to hide a bill or a valuable paper. Wrap the paper tightly around the tube and push it well down into the pen-tip recess. It'll stay secure. Then replace the barrel and clip the pen to some article of your clothing.

To make a sauce for barbecued spare ribs combine a quarter cup of cider vinegar, a half cup of savory bottled thick brown sauce (the kind usually used as an accompaniment for cold meat or steak), one and a

half teaspoons salt and two spoons prepared mustard. Pour the liquid mixture over about three pounds of fresh pork ribs and bake in a moderate oven for about an hour and a half. Baste frequently with the sauce, adding a little water at the end of the roasting time, if necessary.

Handkerchiefs should be hung over the line and pinned in the middle instead of at the corners.

Leftover cooked veal may be made into a cold loaf for sandwiches. Grind the meat with a little sweet mustard pickle; add salt and pepper to taste and a little melted butter. Pack the mixture into a small loaf pan that has been lined with waxed paper and chilled overnight in the refrigerator.
