**Road Neglect Scored By Member For 2nd Queen's**

Government neglect of roads and highways in the Second District of Queen's was strongly criticized in the Legislature on Thursday by Mr. J. Phillip Matheson, one of the Conservative members for the District.

Speaking on the Draft Address, Mr. Matheson said that promised road improvements had been so long overdue that the same Liberal pledges made four years ago were used in the campaign last December. The people were still awaiting implementation of the promises to build the West River and North River bridges, and to put the main roads in passable condition. The Government was showing "an extraordinary timidity" in its Public Works Department, out of keeping with its previous boastful attitude.

He instanced the delay in proceeding with the road from Cornwall to Charlottetown, in one of the best rural districts of the Province. This and other roads were referred to by the speaker as being in a disgraceful condition last year.

He also emphasized the importance of the fisheries in North Rustico, where 700 people are supported solely by this industry. "The neglect of the industry in that locality has been great indeed, both by the Federal and Provincial Governments," Mr. Matheson said. "The road to that place is a Provincial responsibility, and should be attended to."

He referred to another road, from New Glasgow to Cavendish, which he wished the officials of the Department of Public Works had driven over and seen for themselves.

Hon. Mr. Barbour: "I have been over it."

Mr. Matheson: "And aren't you ashamed of it?"

Mr. Barbour: "No."

Mr. Matheson: "You aren't? I hope the press when they print that will underline it."

"After all the requests I have made to the Minister in the matter of road work, I don't think I ever received anything yet," Mr. Matheson continued. "Snow plowing falls into the same category."

Mr. Barbour: "No results, eh?"

Mr. Matheson: "None. We hope to see some, but that has been the record so far, and I must speak of it."

He referred also to failure to obtain gravel for his district, when it was being transported right through the constituency, from First Queen's into Third Queen's.

Hon. Mr. Barbour: "We subgraded fifteen miles of road in your district last year."

Mr. Matheson insisted the district did not get its share.

Mr. Barbour: "I think you did."

Mr. Matheson: "What about the Rustico Road, and the New Glasgow Road?"

Mr. Barbour: "We have that ahead of us. We did 14 to 15 miles in your district, but that is nothing at all, I suppose."

Mr. Matheson: "Nothing in comparison with what you did in First Queen's—or in Second Prince the year before."
