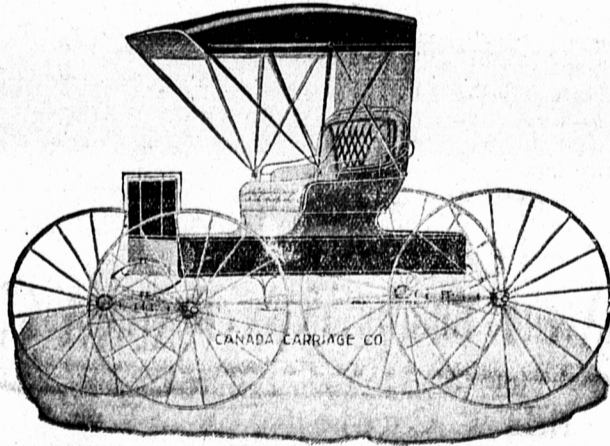

SPRINGHILL CHILD SHOT DEAD WITH REVOLVER.

SPRINGHILL MINES, July 23.—Yesterday morning, a boy about eight years of age, son of John Booth, a prosperous English miner, of Springhill, went to the house of his married sister, a short distance from his own home, accompanied by an older brother. In the absence of his sister the older boy went into a room and got hold of a revolver that turned out to be loaded. After amusing himself with it he gave it to the younger boy and in some way not exactly known, it was discharged, the bullet entered the younger boy's head, causing his death after a few hours.

ITALIAN ARRESTED ON SUSPICION.

HALIFAX, July 23.—Some days ago it was reported that a man had passed a worthless \$10 note in a store on Upper Water Street. A two dollar note had been raised to ten dollars. The police evidently took no interest in the matter, but Deputy Sheriff Scriven and Jailer Mitchell took the case up, and as a result of their good work, together with that of I. C. R. officer Purcell, an arrest has been made, and they believe that they have the right man. Early last evening these officers visited the woods in the vicinity of the Three Mile House, and they found an Italian, who was enjoying his supper. He was placed under arrest. He had a trunk with him, and in it was found a quantity of dyes, rubber stamps, brushes, etc. The prisoner is about forty-five years of age, and he answers the description of the man who passed the note.

DR. CRIPPENS LAWYER GETS PENITENTARY.

LONDON, July 23.—A three years' term of penal servitude was imposed today at the Old Bailey session on Arthur Newton, the lawyer who came into prominence during the trial of Dr. Crippen for murder. He was charged with conspiracy to defraud Dr. Hans Thorsch, a wealthy young citizen of Vienna, out of \$115,000 by false pretences in 1911 and 1912. Newton's companion, Berkley Bernard Bennett, was sentenced at the same time to eighteen months' hard labor. The judge characterized the prisoners' action as a gross conspiracy to defraud Thorsch. In the course of the testimony it was shown that Thorsch was induced by the conspirators to part with his fortune on the pretense that it was to be invested for him and the investments chosen were "wild cat" schemes.

It consists of 24 battleships and three battle-cruisers—twenty-seven heavy ships in all; eight cruiser squadrons, two light cruiser squadrons, a squadron of mine-layers, five destroyer flotillas, numbering 100 boats, and four submarine flotillas. The "red" fleet consists of sixteen battleships, two battle-cruisers, one cruiser squadron, three attached cruisers, one light cruiser squadron, three destroyer flotillas, or 60 boats, and two submarine flotillas.

The problem to be solved is whether an enemy, such as Germany, with this greatly inferior strength, can land troops in sufficient force to paralyze British credit, intimidate public security, and impede the overseas food supplies without which England would be starved in three weeks.

BLIND FOR 50 YEARS, SHE REGAINS SIGHT

CHICAGO, July 23.—One of the humblest homes in Hillsdale, Mich., was made the happiest in the whole country to-day when Mrs. Mary J. Welsh, who has been blind for fifty years, recovered her sight. When she was a girl of sixteen her eyes failed until she became entirely blind. In that condition she married and is the mother of eight children whom she never saw until to-day. To make her burden doubly hard, her husband became ill, and she was forced to take in washing to support the family. She struggled on until the children were able to earn some money for themselves. Then things became a bit easier for her, but her sightless eyes still ached for a sight of the children. Several operations were tried and were unsuccessful. The sons, now grown up, brought the mother to Chicago, where she was taken to a hospital for treatment. Surgeons examined her and found she was suffering from a double cataract. She was discharged from the hospital to-day, and two sons and a daughter greeted her. She was taken home to Hillsdale, where the entire family welcomed her.
