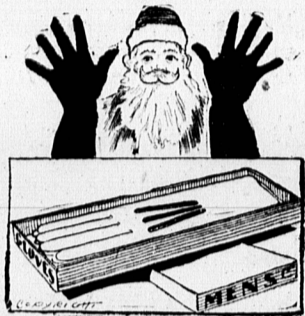

## MISS LAURA McD STALLO ENTERS INTO SOCIETY

### A Popular Young Society Lady Who Made Many Friends During Her Stay in This Province.

CINCINNATI, Ohio, Dec. 17.—There was an engaging touch of the European to the reception at Dalvay recently at which Alexander McDonald presented his granddaughter, Miss Laura McDonald Stallo, which rather differentiated the function from the average of even other splendid events, and set it upon a pinnacle all its own. The servants were uniformed in scarlet liveries. The guests were announced as they entered the drawing room. The unaccustomed gleam of scarlet among the really royal floral decorations of the house and the more subdued tones of the costumes of the guests made a striking note in the splendor of Dalvay's halls and gave emphasis to the general brilliancy of the scene. Mr. McDonald, stately and gracious, and the lovely girl, who now takes her place as mistress of Dalvay, received alone in the broad bay window of the drawing room, with the glimpse of the green of the conservatory back of them brilliantly enlivened by an artistic arrangement of the hundreds of bouquets sent to the debutante. Miss Stallo wore a simple, but very beautiful dress of white satin, with crystal fringes on the corsage and a rope of pearls about her throat. Her bouquet was a splendid cluster of gardenias and lilies of the valley. Just outside the ballroom door, the debutante's sister, Miss Helena Stallo, who will be presented next year, greeted the guests. She wore a charming frock of white tissue with bands of silver lace. The decorations were exquisitely wrought out—the most artistic ideas combining to make a perfect whole and creating an effect as delicately rosy as a summer dawn. Hundreds of pink shades veiled the lights of the chandeliers and tall lamps glowed beneath the shadow of floral umbrellas. The windows, with their pink, blue, and white, were draped with smilax, and between them big French gilt baskets were overflowing with pink carnations. The great crystal chandeliers of the ballroom were also shaded in pink, and it was down the splendid length of this room that the buffet table was spread. This was a masterpiece of arrangement and design. In the center, above the table, and with the glided pipes of the great pipe organ as background, a peacock spread the glory of its plumage and two orange trees with their golden fruit, rose above the massive silver candelabra which once adorned the table of the duke of Cambridge, and which form a part of the famous McDonald plate. The masterpieces of the caterers' and the confectioners' arts, the baskets of spun sugar, spilling their sweets upon the cloth, the plaques of set pieces, the splendid silver dishes, made an array that was dazzling in its beauty. The front entrance to Dalvay was closed, the guests arriving by the gardens and the marble corridor in the rear, where a hedge of glowing azaleas flanked the marble seats. The reception hours were from 8 until 11, but the young people stayed for dancing, winding up with a gay virginia reel as the first streaks of dawn began to dim the glory of the moon.—The Times Star.
