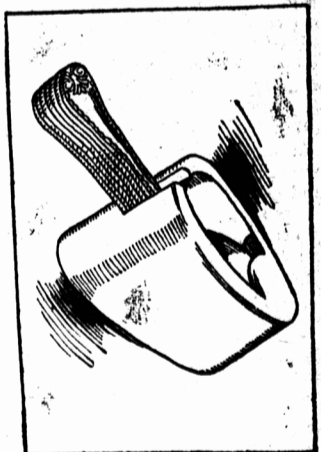
Barter and Sale of a Woman in a London Court
