## France Plans to Ship Live Lobsters Across Atlantic

HALIFAX, Feb. 28.—A big fish firm in Paris, France, has been working on plans for the shipment of live lobsters across the Atlantic. The project involves the construction of a fleet of about twenty tons capacity in which the live lobsters will be kept. These trucks will be loaded on steamers bound for France and the water in the tanks will be changed as circumstances require. The problem which was the adoption of this method of placing Canadian lobsters on the markets of France, is the probable effect of the changes of temperature in the Atlantic upon the lobsters. Live lobsters have for many years been shipped from Nova Scotia to Boston, Mass., in well packed, and then kept for weeks in tanks at that port before being sold. And by all accounts the lobsters usually flourish in captivity. Live water tanks were shipped with water tanks from the St. Lawrence River to New York, and though the mortality among the lobsters was great it is said the value of the live lobsters is compared with the value of the dressed lobsters which is sold.

## Princess Mary's Wedding In Westminster Abbey

### Scene Unmatched for Royal Splendor and Brilliance Since the Coronation of King George Took Place Yesterday in London.

(Special to The Guardian) WESTMINSTER ABBEY, London, Feb. 28.—Princess Mary of Britain today became the bride of Viscount Lascelles. In a wedding ceremony marked for its beauty and solemnity. The popular Princess and the man of her choice, a British commander, were married shortly before noon in the presence of an assembly of peers, commoners, and visiting royalty. Historic Westminster Abbey was a scene of unsurpassed beauty as the Princess, on the arm of her father moved down the aisle to the magnificent altar where Viscount Lascelles stood waiting. In a brief but impressive church of England wedding service the couple were united by the Archbishop of Canterbury. Fifteen other English clergymen assisted in the ceremony. The King himself placed Princess Mary's hand in that of Viscount Lascelles. Princess Victoria Alexandra Alice Mary, as she is called during the marriage service, promised to love, honor and obey her husband who stood proudly erect as the Archbishop pronounced the concluding words that made them man and wife at 11:43. During the actual wedding ceremony Viscount Lascelles was nervous his face flushed. By his side Princess Mary was very solemn, her face alternately pale and rosy pink. Mary could be seen to nod her head emphatically when she heard "I will". LONDON, Feb. 28.—As she passed the entrance in Whitehall on the return from Westminster Abbey after the ceremony, Princess Mary reached from the carriage window and handed out a bouquet which a Sergeant Major grasped and placed on the coronation as a tribute from the Princess to Great Britain's dead in the war. NEW YORK, Feb. 28.—The marriage ceremony of Viscount Lascelles and Princess Mary is to be broadcasted by radio-phonograph and by the Archbishop of Canterbury pronounces the Royal couple man and wife the words may possibly be heard in New York. ## Lonely Island is Chosen Sepulcher For Shackleton

NEW YORK, February 2.—Grytviken, chosen by Lady Shackleton as the last resting place for the body of her late husband, Sir Ernest Shackleton, the British Explorer who died aboard his ice-craft Quest last January 5, is an icebound isolated habitation of 20 persons who cling to the frozen shores of South Georgia Island, called the "Gateway to Antarctica". Sir Ernest's body was brought from the Antarctic to Grytviken, following his death and will be accompanied by Captain Frank Hussey, one of the explorers on the expedition, when it parts again on its journey into the Polar regions. Lady Shackleton's decision to have the removal of the body to England is in accordance with a long wish of the explorer that he be laid to rest amid the scenes where his life work had been carried on. Only at the outset of his last voyage, he told friends, he wanted to die with his boots on like an old sea dog.

## EGYPT NOW FREE FOR NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT
