### Teuton Smuggling Plot is Revealed

NEW YORK, Nov. 4.—A plot to beat the British blockade and violate American neutrality before the entrance of this nation into war was admitted today in the United States District Court by Hans Hassen, former chief steward of the liner Christianiafjord.

Before Judge Ervin, Hassen pleaded guilty to an attempt to get unmanifested rubber out of this port without the knowledge of the customs authorities at a time when rubber was very necessary to the German Empire and when a break between this nation and the Central Powers was daily expected.

After admitting his own guilt Hassen took the stand as a witness for the government against Oscar and Joseph Newman, importers and exporters, of the Flatiron building, who are accused of conspiracy with him, and Sven Du Ritz and William Henn, two other Scandinavians alleged to have been parties to the plot.

Questioned by John C. Knox, Chief Assistant United States Attorney, the ship's steward told the court how he had arranged to place in the music room of the big liner a phonograph cabinet which had been specially manufactured with secret compartments in which rubber could be placed aboard the vessel, he said.

Detectives Barnitz and Busby, and other members of the police bomb squad, told how they had been informed of the scheme by the maker of these trunks and had watched the Newman offices. All of the men whom they arrested for supposed participation in the scheme were of Scandinavian or Danish extraction.

### POPE'S NOTE BASIS OF GERMAN POLICY

(Canadian Press Despatch) Amsterdam, Nov. 4.—Count von Hertling has accepted the following demands of the Reichstag majority according to the Vossische Zeitung: First—That Prussian electoral reform be carried out. Second—That political censorship and the state of siege be abolished or mitigated. Third—That the foreign policy be conducted on the basis of the German reply to the Pope's peace note.

### CORN EXPORT PROHIBITED

WASHINGTON, Nov. 3.—The War Trade Board yesterday issued an order prohibiting the export of corn except in special cases where sufficient evidence of the necessity of export is established.

"This is due to the late arrival of the new corn harvest," said the Board's announcement, "and exporters have been warned not to make any shipments of contracts for shipments unless licenses have been previously received."
