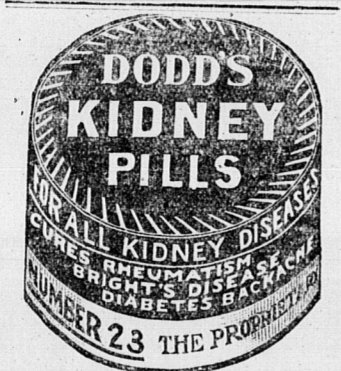

### DEBATE ON POSTAL SITUATION.

PARIS, May 12.—The Chamber of Deputies after a stormy session, adjourned the debate on the postal situation until May 13th. The response of the Postal employees was decisive. Within half an hour the Federal Committee had issued an order for a general strike and the railway men clerks walked out in a body. An hour later a meeting of six thousand Postal employees unanimously voted to strike. There was no great enthusiasm, but a determination and resolution to force the hand of the Government.

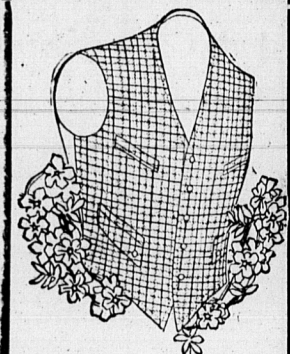

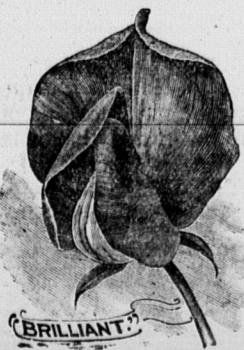
