#### FATAL ACCIDENT ON EXCURSION TRAIN

 LA TROBE, Pa., July 6—Seven persons were killed and a number fatally injured and 30 others hurt at 4.30 yesterday afternoon, when a passenger train on the Ligonier Valley Railroad was smashed from behind by a double-header freight train. Only one passenger escaped without injury. The accident occurred at the fair grounds at Killpen, one-half mile from the Ligonier summer resort.

The passenger train had started from Ligonier. It consisted of an engine and coach, the engine pushing the coach. The freight train was made up of many coal cars and was being pulled by two heavy locomotives.

The impact was terrific, the passenger coach being practically laid open and passengers either crushed or thrown like shots through the air. It was the most fatal accident, it is said, in the history of the road for the past forty years.

#### DEMOCRATS AND INSURGENTS OUT

 WASHINGTON, July 6—The working agreement between the Democratic and Insurgent Republican Senators is at an end.

It has been abrogated as the end of the conference since the bill was passed by the Democrats in the absence of the regular Republicans and without the aid of the Insurgents.

The probable result will be that the House the sugar and wool and excise bills will be presented to the Senate and voted down by a strictly party vote.

All the Republicans are expected to vote against them and it is probable that some of the Democrats will join them in opposing to the House or the sugar bill which would admit sugar free of duty.

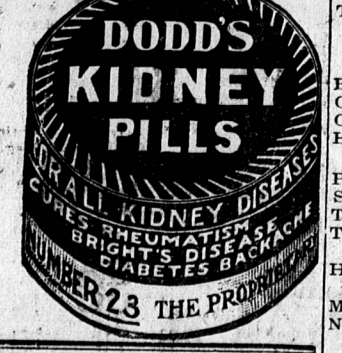
