A public meeting of the Long Creek Farmers' Institute was held in the A.L.C. Hall on April 13th to discuss the proposed act taxing dogs in the interest of sheep breeders and the enrolment of stallions, also the repeal of the present automobile act. After some discussion the taxing of dogs met with general disfavor. It was agreed that the enrolment of stallions would be a protection to the horse breeder. A general discussion took place on the repeal of the Auto Act, after which the following resolution was moved and carried—Resolved that in the opinion of this meeting, the present act prohibiting automobiles running on the public roads is not in the best interest of the Province, and that it be repealed, and another act passed allowing them to run, under such restrictions and regulations as would insure the safety of the public.

Bourke, was adopted by a unanimous vote: Resolved, that the members of this church have heard with great regret the announcement of our rector's resignation; and we here desire to express our sincere appreciation of the diligence and faithfulness with which Rev. Mr. Winter has performed his duties as rector of this parish—diligence and faithfulness which will cause his reverence to be remembered as one of the most faithful and devoted clergymen that ever came to Cherry Valley.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Subagency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties.—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may, pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$100 per acre.

Duties.—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$2.00 per acre. Duties.—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.
