The attention of all dog owners is called to Section 9 of the City By-Law Relating to Dogs and the Taxing Thereof, which reads as follows:
9. (a) No person shall permit his dog or bitch to be on any street without the collar mentioned in the third section of this By-law.
(b) No person shall allow his dog or bitch to be at large on or about the streets of said City.
(c) Any dog or bitch which shall be on or about the streets of said City and shall not be in the immediate company of or under the reasonable control of its owner or some competent person, shall be deemed to be at large.
(d) The Police Constables of said City shall take and retain any dog or bitch found at large, and shall deliver same to its owner only upon application and payment of two dollars forfeit for such taking, and subject to any provision for infraction of this By-law. Any dog or bitch which cannot be taken by the Police with reasonable expedition and safety may be by the Police destroyed forthwith.
(e) Any dog or bitch found at large after its owner has been notified of its having been previously at large shall be deemed to be habitually at large.
(f) Any dog or bitch which shall be habitually at large in said City may be destroyed by the Police.
(g) No owner shall permit his dog or bitch to unreasonably annoy any citizen by continuous barking or otherwise.
A Dog Catcher has been appointed for the enforcement of the above, and any dog or bitch found running at large on or after Monday, March 24, 1947, will be picked up.
