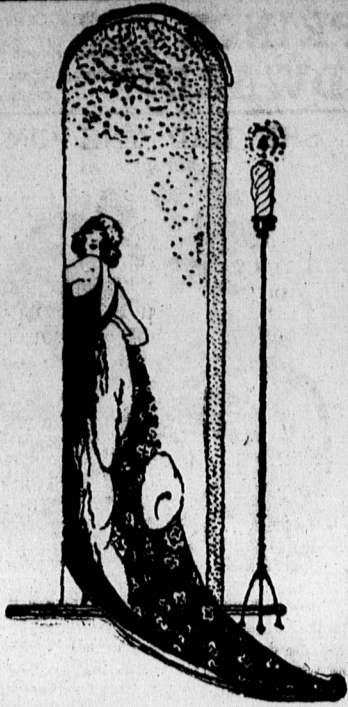

and since emancipation was, the speaker urged, a supreme example of the power of the Gospel in preparing men and women for loyalty to the law and order imposed by a settled system of government. A highly-placed colonial official's statement that the Missionary's work made law enforcement not only easier, but possible was quoted. At the evening service the preacher spoke of "Christian Internationalism." Jesus, he said placed Christianity not at the centre of a race but of humanity. He had no use for the merely parochial or provincial outlook.
