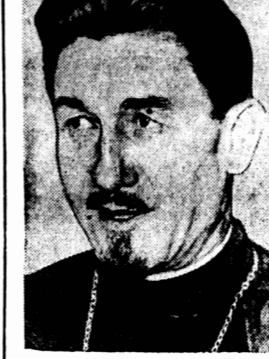

Mr. Horne was a son of the late Alexander Horne of Charlottetown, in which city he grew up and attended school. Upon finishing school he worked for a time with the Barons of Prince Edward Island...
