## Cook's Corner

SPICED RHUBARB MUFFINS

These moist muffins absolutely demand that they be served hot—and it might be that you would like a sweet spread with them rather than butter. The same batter would turn out individual puddings for you—also an interesting piping hot, and with an interesting sweet sauce.

This recipe is definitely for people who like a little tang in something that belongs to the sweet course.

Yield—10 smallish muffins or puddings.

1 cup once-sifted hard-wheat flour  
3/4 cup once-sifted pastry flour  
1/2 cup sugar  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon  
1/2 teaspoon ground ginger  
1/4 teaspoon grated nutmeg  
1 cup quick-cooking rolled oats  
1/3 cup brown sugar, lightly packed  
3 tablespoons chilled shortening  
1 egg  
1/2 cup milk  
1/2 teaspoon vanilla  
1 cup 1/4-inch dice of raw rhubarb.

Measure and sift together twice, the flour, baking powder, salt, cinnamon, sugar and nutmeg; mix in rolled oats and sugar. Add the shortening and cut it in finely. Beat the egg until thick and light; stir in milk, vanilla and rhubarb. Make a well in the dry mixture and pour in the liquid mixture all at once; combine lightly. Pour into greased muffin pans. Bake in moderately hot oven, 375 degrees, 25 to 30 minutes.

Serve hot, as muffins; or if desired, serve hot as a baked pudding, with pouring cream or a suitable sauce.

There is, however, still something to be done by way of preventing waterful preparation and clearing up. If the necessary saving can be effected without further rationing the effort will be well worth-while. The best incentive is a realization of the great need. Food economy is not now a fad or a stunt. It is a response to the dreadful threat of hunger and death for many.
