A PRINCE'S TOUR.

LONDON, June 13—Times despatch from Tokio announces that ex-Premier Prince Katsura will leave early in June on a tour of Europe. Announcement gives rise in abundance to political rumors.

The prince himself says he is merely going on a sight-seeing trip, but the journey undoubtedly has a political aspect. It is argued in some quarters that his chief mission is to St. Petersburg, where he goes first, and it is noteworthy that he will be accompanied by Baron Goto, who is well known in the Russian capital. The J-J expresses the belief that Prince Katsura's special endeavors will be directed toward clearing away the clouds which at present are obscuring the value of the Anglo-Japanese alliance the life it had before the Russian hand, the equally influential Asahi frankly confesses that it is hopeless to think of installing again into the alliance the life it had before the Russo-Japanese agreement and declares that Prince Katsura will find more to do in St. Petersburg than in London.

TRANSCONTINENTAL STATIONS.

OTTAWA, June 13—Tenders for the construction of twenty-five standard A stations and two terminal D stations on the line of the National Transcontinental railway between Cochrane and Superior junction, at the probable cost of from \$250,000 and \$300,000 will be opened here tomorrow. The tenders include, besides the station buildings, trainmen's houses costing about \$15,000 each and equipped with shower baths and all modern improvements calculated to make the employees comfortable; store houses, freight houses and coal pockets. The contractors will be required to have the stations completed within three months after the tracks are laid to them.

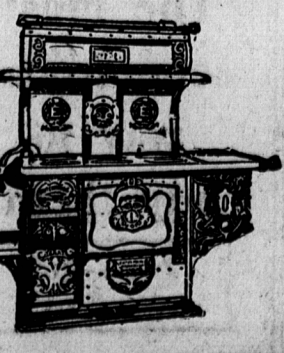
