### Magdalen's To Have County Health Unit

MONTREAL, Dec. 17 — Far-off Magdalen Islands, unknown to most people in Montreal, but lying in the Gulf of St. Lawrence on the route along which the Gloucester fishermen travel to get to the Great Banks for the cod fishing, have decided to get into step with modern hygienic progress and to have a county health unit of its own.

Politically the islands, five main pieces of land far from being noted for fertility, form part of the Province of Quebec, though geographically their position on the map shows them to be much closer to Nova Scotia, and steamship services there are via Nova Scotia ports.

The creation of county health units, which came into being in 1928, when Hon. Thus, the Magdalen Islands will be the only addition to the roll of counties with county health units which has come into being during the year 1933. There are some well settled counties in the province, comparatively prosperous, which so far have refused to cooperate in a project for a county health unit.

Under the system in vogue the Government, Mr. Rockefeller Foundation bear the largest portion of the burden for the first few years, and then the Foundation drops out, leaving a heavier burden upon the Government, but the statistics show that they have consistently shown that the improvement in public health in counties covered by the operations of the health units is very great.

In addition to the medical health officer in charge, there is in some instances a sanitary engineer attached to the unit, and always two or more nurses. The latter specialize in visiting the schools and examining the children, as well as giving general counsel, under medical direction, always, throughout their respective territories.

### Selection Hard In Bacon Export

In summarizing the conditions of the Canadian domestic meat market, the Live Stock Meat Trade Review says:—

A great many pigs which carry fairly good finish, and are of select and good bacon type, are at the low end of the select weights. It should be borne in mind that most of our good bacon, which comes from the bacon and select grades of hogs, the weight range of which is from 180 to 230 lbs., does not represent the preference of the British Bacon trade unless the product of hogs weighing around 200 to 220 lbs., on the farm.

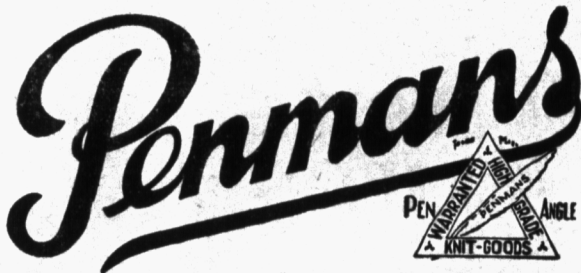
