MISPLACING THE BLAME

South attributed his defeat in today's deal to a horrible trump break but he ignored the fact that his own bidding had been considerably less snappy than it might have been.

South dealer. Both sides vulnerable.

♠ A K 2 0 ♠ J 2 0 9
♥ 6 5 3 ♥ 8 3
♦ 10 9 ♦ 7
♣ J 7 5 3 ♣ A K Q 6 5 2

West opening: 1♣ North: 2♥ East: 2♠ South: 3♥

West opened the heart king and South ruffed two rounds of trumps brought the bad news, and now South shifted over to the diamond suit. East ruffed the second round and laid down the club king. Declarer won, but there was no hope of avoiding the loss of two trump tricks and two clubs.

It should be observed that East was well advised to double the four-ace contract since North-South then might have "found each other" in diamonds. It was too bad, however, that they could not have discovered for themselves the beautiful fit in diamonds that would

have made a grand slam at that denomination an absolute lay-down against any defense.

The North-South failure in this respect was due to South's unimaginative takeout of the two-heart double. Void of hearts as he was, he was absolutely right in refusing to accept the double, but he was absolutely wrong when he jumped to four spades North's double had been an "in-it warning" against spades but it was not at all unlikely that North had length in one of the minors. Since South had been close to an opening two-bid he should have seized the opportunity to take the double out with a cue-bid in the opponents' heart suit. North, of course, would have responded with his long diamond suit and South would have had every justification to raise the diamond bid to at least a small slam.
