#### THE BRITISH WAR OFFICE SCANDAL

LONDON, October 18.—The war office has issued its decisions in the cases of officers involved in the South African war stores scandals. General Sir Neville Gerald Lyttleton, chief of the general staff and first military member of the army council, is completely exonerated. Secretary of war Haldane and the army council arriving at the conclusion that it was beyond human possibility for General Lyttleton to appreciate the system of supplies while his whole energies were being devoted to commanding the troops. Several officers are censured and others retired with and without pay allowed retired officers. Many others are exonerated and restored to service. A note appended to the decision states that in all the cases full allowances have been made for defects in the supply system as well as for the effects on the men of the long and severe strain of active service.

The West stake went to Exton in straight heats. He won as he pleased.

The 2:07 pace was won by Vesta Boy after he had lost the first heat to Alfalfa. Bystander won the 2:15 pacing without difficulty. In the 2:10 trot L. J. Lewis, the favorite, was drawn after hurting himself in the first heat. The race was postponed until tomorrow after Monro had won two heats and Vanzaud two.

"DURING THEIR stay at Halifax, driver Frank P. Fox and his American friends took a marked liking to handsome and fast mare, Simasie, 2,064.

The Americans, it is said, were willing to pay \$1,500 for Simasie, but the owners are said to have put the price on the black pacer mare at \$2,500.

Driver Fox, in conversation with friends during the Halifax meeting, did not hesitate to say that it was his opinion that Simasie, with a driver like Walter Cox behind her, would be able to beat out Gloria, 2,104, his own mare, in the majority of their races.

It is well for the sake of the racing game that driver Boutlier and his partner did not allow their speedy mare to leave the province.

The Halifax Recorder adds:—Now that the above has been made public, it may also be stated that a well known Nova Scotia horseman offered \$2,000 for her. Her owners cannot see where they could replace her as such a figure. The Boston man wanted over \$2,000 for Gloria, and she is several years older than Simasie.

#### BRITAIN BUILDS GREAT CRUISERS

LONDON, Oct. 18.—The Daily Telegraph says it learns that the three so-called armoured-cruisers, the Invincible, the Inflexible and the Indomitable, which are now being built at the Clyde and Tyne, are in reality a new type of battleship, having a broadside fire equal to that of the Dreadnaught, and a much higher speed.

The paper says they will be the most wonderful ships ever built for any fleet, having greater offensive power than a 7 two battleships now in commission, combined with extraordinary speed. There has been some more or less mysterious secrecy regarding the vessels since they were authorized in the spring of 1905, as was the case with the Dreadnaught, and the present revelations come as a surprise.

The new ships will be of 17,350 tons, compared with the Dreadnaught's 17,500, but they will be forty feet longer. Their breadth will be 31 1/2 feet less than the Dreadnaught's.

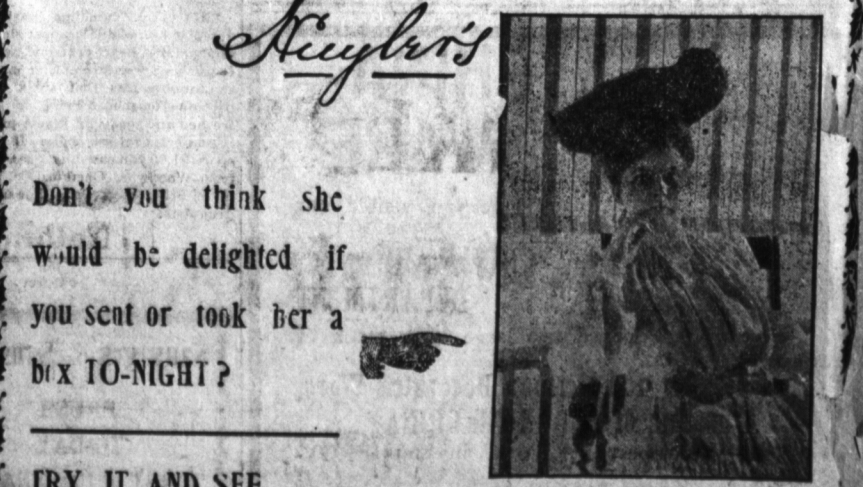
