DECLARATIONS OF WAR.

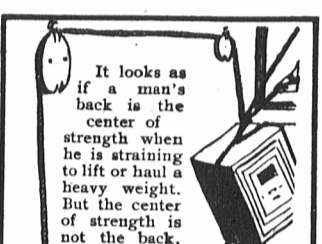
The Czar in his manifesto to the Russian people complains that the Japanese have outraged national usage by beginning the war without making a formal declaration of war.

"The Imperial Government have no other alternative than to terminate the present futile negotiations. In adopting this course the Imperial Government reserve to themselves the right to take such independent action as they may deem best to consolidate and defend their menaced position, as well as to protect their established rights and legitimate interests."

If a formal declaration of war, more explicit than that made by the retiring Japanese Minister at St. Petersburg, were necessary to justify the commencement of hostilities, then Russia is herself the guilty party.
