THE entertainment to have been given last night by the young people of St. Mary's congregation is postponed indefinitely on account of the storm and the impassable condition of the streets.

YESTERDAY was Declaration Day in the Fourth and Fifth districts of Prince County. The complete returns are as follows: DesRoches 493; Campbell 433, majority for DesRoches 60; Reid 792; McQuarrie 701—majority for Reid 91.

THE storm of yesterday and the previous night was the worst experienced here for several years. The roads and streets are almost completely blocked and business practically at a stand still. The eastern train arrived a little after twelve (noon) but the western train is still fighting the drift.

THE hockey match next Friday evening between the 1st Abbies of Charlottetown, and the Stars of Summerside, will be a hot one. The former hold the championship of the Island, while the latter are in a better condition than ever before to put up a good game. In addition to this the Anchors of Charlottetown, are prepared to make the fight of their lives in endeavoring to win from our Britannia's the laurels lost on the 18th of Jan. Those who wish to see the hottest games ever played in Crystal Rink should be present. Admission 25 cents; children 15 cents.

THE regular monthly meeting of the Town Council was held Monday evening, the chairman and all the councillors present. After reading minutes of previous meeting a number of bills were passed and some laid over for consideration. Four applications for the position of town clerk were read and laid over. The chairman read an itemized statement showing that the defalcations through irregularities in the town accounts, previously referred to in THE GUARDIAN, amounted in all to \$5,675.15, besides several accounts unsettled and whose validity is still in doubt. He also explained that he had the authority of his legal advisors for stating that the securities held by the town were good for at least \$3,000.00. It was decided to hold a public civic meeting in Market Hall this Wednesday evening, the 15th inst. Council adjourned until Monday evening the 20th inst.
