TOTAL DEFEAT OF THE LAURIER GOVERNMENT AND RECIPROCITY

Special to The Guardian. CHENG TU, Sept. 21—It is estimated that two thousand insurgents besieging Cheng Tu have been killed. Foreign residents have not been able to leave the capital.

Special to The Guardian. MANILA, Sept. 21—The danger of famine in the Philippines on account of the failure of the rice crop has become so threatening that Governor General Forbes purchased a shipload of cereals in Ragoon. The cargo will be sold to people at cost.

Special to The Guardian. DETROIT, Sept. 21—The strike of Detroit railway employes was today settled by arbitration. The rate of wages granted to the men was within a half a cent of that originally demanded.

The victors are naturally jubilant and the defeated party must bear its loss with such philosophy as may be at command.

A notable feature is that half the members of the Laurier Cabinet were defeated. At this writing it would seem that Sir Frederick Borden, Hon. Messrs Fielding, Fisher, Graham, Paterson, King and Templeman are among the slain—an unprecedented defeat in that regard. And Ontario gave astonishing results.
