**The Hay Crop Outlook**  
Trade Bulletin 16 June.  
At the present time, the hay crop of this province promises to be a phenomenally heavy one, as our advices from all sections are of the same optimistic character as regards the condition of the fields and meadows, and the heavy growth of timothy and clover. On both the North and South sides of the river, the reports are of the same encouraging nature. A subscriber who called upon us last Friday from the Yamaska Section, also joined in the chorus of good crop reports. The quality of the growing crop is said to be excellent, the cool weather having checked a rank growth which would have been induced had a hot spell set in after the copious rains. Warmer weather now would improve things immensely.

**THE FRUIT CROP.**  
OTTAWA, Ont., June 15th, 1916. The Fruit Branch of the Department of Agriculture has today received the following information, by telegram, regarding the condition of small fruits in various parts of Canada.—  
**NOVA SCOTIA.**—Prospects are exceptionally good for a large strawberry crop. The fruit will not be marketed in any large quantities before July 5th.  
**NEW BRUNSWICK.**—Strawberries will be at their best between July 12 and 18. The acreage is about the same as last year. Raspberries will be about one month later in maturing. All small fruits promise normal yields.  
**QUEBEC.**—Strawberry season will be at its height about June 24 and raspberries two weeks later. All plants have wintered well.  
**ONTARIO.**—Strawberries maturing very rapidly. The fruit made its first appearance on the Hamilton market on June 13. Heavy shipments will be made from the Niagara Peninsula next week. The quality promises to be very high.  
**BRITISH COLUMBIA.**—Strawberries maturing rapidly. Small lots

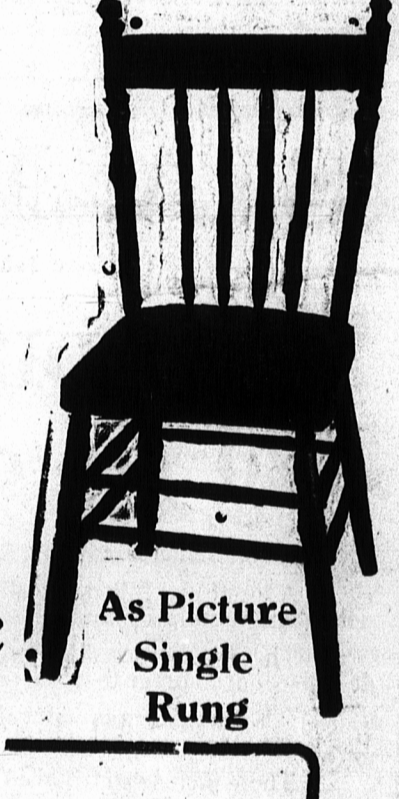
