has no interest in the western farmer, fixed these duties, not at the 17 1/2 per cent at which he was quite content to have it when in power, not at the 15 per cent, fixed by the reciprocity agreement which he has never ceased to praise in this House, but at 12 1/2 per cent. And when he raised the tariff two years ago the increase did not apply to these agricultural implements. I think I have proved that my hon. friend is not quite sincere in bringing forward this motion. If he indicates this Government for not dealing with the question of agricultural implements he must explain to his constituents why, when he was in power, he did not do what he now says this Government ought to do.

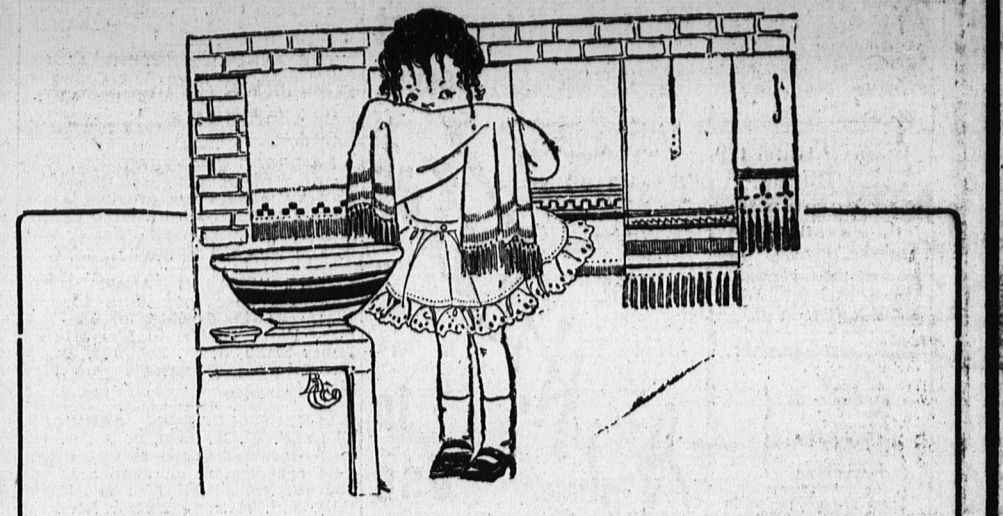
