### THE POST BELLUM POLICY OF JAPAN

TOKIO, Oct. 2.—Mr. Matsuoka, Minister of Agriculture and Commerce, says in an interview that "people should remember the maxim that 'gold is sharper than the sword,' and that the expansion of commerce and industry creates the closest friendship between nations. For this reason, the post-bellum policy of Japan will be guided by peaceful inclinations and the principle of the open door which leads to the strongest ties, the introduction of foreign capital and the bringing of machinery and experts to work jointly with the Japanese will be welcomed. Encouragement will also be given to the home manufacture of machinery which promises to be an essential factor in increasing the wealth of the country. The minister insists upon the closest ties of commerce and industry, and a general economic relationship with Russia.

### MR. CARNEGIE IS STILL WORRYING

LONDON, Oct. 1.—(Special)—Having supplied most of the requirements in the way of Public Libraries, Andrew Carnegie is now seeking the opinions of School Boards and other public bodies in Scotland as to the best means of disposing of part of his fortune which he desires to distribute during his life for the benefit of humanity, and asks for suggestions regarding the most beneficial objects. He says that while he is willing to assist in providing church organs, no money will be given to support ministers or church services which he considers should be paid by the congregation.

#### A COMPLAINT FROM THE WEST.

SIR,—Your advocacy of the Charlotte-town Exhibition is certainly commendable, but Sir, are you aware of the handicap which the exhibitor west of Summerside is met with? The rules demand that the animal must be on the grounds Monday the eighth at 10 o'clock. In that case, owing to our rapid transit facilities, (it takes two days for freight to reach the city) the exhibitor would have to leave home on Friday, reaching the city Saturday evening, where he would have to remain till the next Friday, after the horse parade, too late to go west on that day's train. Leaving Charlottetown on Saturday, he would get as far as Summerside, where he would remain till Monday arriving home that afternoon, after having lost ten days of valuable time besides being under heavy expense.

Is it any wonder then that a number who intended showing their animals, after waiting till the time of the closing of the entries for some up-to-date arrangement and none being advertised, allowed the 28th of September to pass without sending an entry? Even if at the eleventh hour a different arrangement is announced it is too late, as the books are closed and the exhibitor has ceased to pay that attention to his animal that it demands. This matter of an up-to-date transit should have been advertised so that we, living in the extreme west should have a fair show with our more fortunate neighbors living nearer the city.
